Nuffield Farming Scholarship

CARAS Wales would like to encourage its members to help promote the 2019 Nuffield Farming Scholarship sponsored by the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society.

The aim is to create a study scholarship for a person working in any part of the meat chain, from farmer to retail butcher. Applicants should mostly be established in their own business or in a management position in their company. The normal age would be between 26 and 45 and an important part of their application is how they plan to manage their absence from the business for the 8 to 10 weeks needed for the scholarship.



The closing date for Awards will be 31 July each year. Short-listing for interview will take place in early September and interviews will be held in early October.
