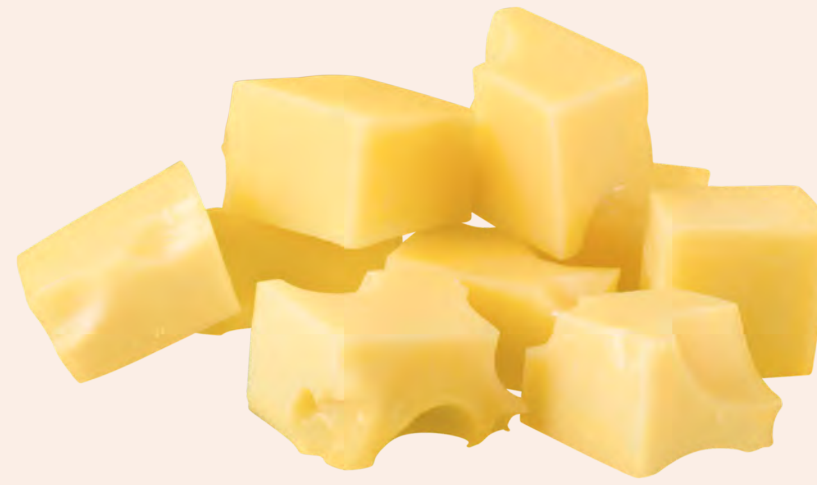


# CARAS – Visit, AGM and Meeting of Council
